nic groups,

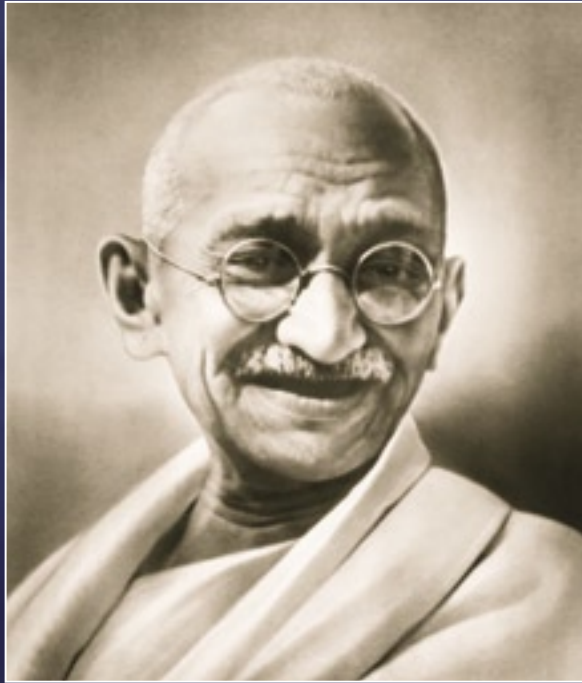
*Sustainable development for*

Initiator of this peace initiative is H. H. Mahamandaleshwar Paramhans Swami Maheshwarananda, founder of International Sri Deep Madhavananda Ashram Fellowship and the System »Yoga in Daily Life«. He is born in Rajasthan, India and has been teaching »Yoga in Daily Life« in Europe over the last 30 years.
